



Schedule 2.1a to the DPA: INSTRUCTIONS – REFAPP REFERENCE CHECKS SERVICE

This schedule constitutes the Customer's instructions to Talentwise pursuant to Article 28 of the GDPR and applies solely to processing carried out within the scope of the Reference Checks service.

Purpose	The Data Processor provides a cloud-based service that the Customer uses to collect references in connection with recruitment of personnel.
Processing activities	Talentwise may only carry out the following processing activities in its role as data processor: • Receive and structure data provided by the Customer, the Candidate, or the Reference; • Send reference requests; • Store and make reference responses available to the Customer; • Administer user accounts and access rights; • Maintain logs for security and operational purposes; • Provide troubleshooting and support related to the Service, including actions taken on behalf of the Customer; • Delete data in accordance with the Service Agreement.

Retention period	• Personal data is retained for twenty-four (24) months, unless otherwise specified in the Service Agreement for Reference Checks. • Logs, technical data, and backups are retained in accordance with Talentwise's ordinary retention routines.
